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**VOLUNTEER CONSTRUCTION SUPERVISOR NEEDED**

Staunton-Augusta-Waynesboro Habitat for Humanity is seeking a Volunteer Construction Supervisor as a part-time member of their mission staff. Responsibilities include the management of the construction of one house per year, from the installation of footings through the final completion of punch list items. Construction superintendents work primarily on site from March through September (usually Thursday and Saturday from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.) and attend the Construction Committee one evening a month.

Primary duties include directing and training skilled and unskilled volunteers, supervising paid and volunteer house leaders, directing and monitoring subcontractors, developing each house construction schedule, ordering the proper materials for just-in-time use according to the construction schedule and critical path of work flow, applying for proper permits, ordering and monitoring inspections, and assurance and compliance to appropriate building codes and achievement of Energy Star and EarthCraft designation for homes built.

The successful candidate will possess excellent interpersonal skills and a thorough, demonstrated knowledge of affordable residential construction. Qualifications include proficiency in using MS Word, Excel, and Outlook, and adaptability to the use of scheduling and management software, organization skills, a knowledge of building materials, understanding of subcontractor work and requirements, construction management skills, job safety skills, a team commitment, excellent verbal and written communication skills in individual and group settings, a valid driver's license, a love of working outside in the midst of visual accomplishment, and a willingness to work well with a diverse range of people. Previous experience with AmeriCorps or mission work, a previous or current license for practicing general residential contracting, and a technical degree are all plusses. A positive attitude, capable leadership, adaptability to changing priorities, and a commitment to the Habitat mission are necessary for success. Note: If semi-retired builder is willing to put in a 40 hr. week, a stipend salary with medical benefits through the AmeriCorps grant program is possible, but the number of houses supervised and duties would increase.
